- Bi-weekly academic conferences on Monday 16:30-18:00 and Thursday 06:30-08:00. ~300 hours / year, ~12 residents / year; These conferences focus on teaching the entire core curriculum of plastic surgery over a three year period. Residents will be exposed to the entire curriculum twice during the six-year residency. Both didactic and the case based presentations are given by the staff. Each conference is created in a comprehensive fashion for the given topic. The residents are given reading assignments in advance and asked to send any questions in advance to the lecturer. The lecture is then designed to augment the readings and answer any questions left after the reading.
